



We invite you to apply for the Hartford Rib Off Scholarship

A \$2,500 scholarship (non-renewable) will be awarded to a graduating senior in good standing either from an accredited Hartford, CT High School or who resides in Hartford, CT, and who has shown commitment to their community through volunteer service.

This scholarship is expressly intended to alleviate expenses related to college living which are not covered by academic scholarships. Our aim is to reduce the burden of these expenses so that this student can concentrate on learning, not on worrying about paying for necessary items.

Mission Statement: Through family friendly BBQ and community-building events, the Hartford Rib Off is committed to raising awareness and funding to support the various objectives of Greater Hartford nonprofit organizations.



SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Requirements and Prerequisites

- Must be a student in good standing either from an accredited High School in Hartford, CT, or residing in Hartford, CT, graduating in June of 2020.
- Must be accepted or enrolled at a 2 or 4 year college and plan to be enrolled full time in the fall semester of 2020
- *Immediate and extended family members of the Hartford Rib Off, Inc. Board of Directors or Advisory Board are not eligible to apply.*

Scholarship Considerations

- Commitment to the community through volunteer service – 50%
- Essay question response – 40%
- Letter of recommendation – 5%
- Academic achievement – 5%

Required Materials for Application

- Completed scholarship application (incomplete applications will not be considered)
- A student resume no more than 2 pages in length which includes your volunteer service (single sided)
- Official **sealed** high school transcript
- One letter of recommendation from a supervisor, leader or Executive Director for an organization or group that you volunteer for in a **sealed envelope**
- Copy of Letter of acceptance from college you plan to enroll in
- Write an essay (no more than 350 words) in response to the prompt question provided on the application
- Please do not submit any other materials other than those requested, they will not be considered in the evaluation process

Review and Evaluation Process

- All applications must be postmarked by **April 15, 2020**
- Applications will be evaluated by a committee
- Each committee member will score in the 4 categories and the administrator will tally and compile the scores
- The scholarship recipient will be notified in early June
- The winner will be invited to be our guest along with their parents or guardians at the 11th Annual Hartford Rib Off, on June 20, 2020, to be recognized as the scholarship recipient.
